

2007 ApHCC LONGE LINE SCORE SHEET

This class is to reward: (1) Movement, (2) Manners/Expression/Attitude, and (3) Conformation. This class should define what it means to be a “pleasure prospect” or “hunt seat prospect”. Score is based on 80 points Movement, 10 points Manners/Expression/Attitude, 20 points Conformation and 3 points Use of Circle with a total possible score of **113 points**. The horses are not expected to demonstrate behaviour beyond that necessary for a reasonable presentation to the judge. Bucking and playing on the longe line is not to be penalized.

<p>1. MOVEMENT 2. MANNERS/EXPRESSION/ATTITUDE is an overall evaluation of manners, expression, responsiveness, quietness, and pleasant attitude. 3. <p>USE OF CIRCLE (25 foot radius) +3 points (Good to Excellent use of the circle) • Horse consistently stays on the perimeter of the circle with slight looseness in the line. • Horse turns around on the circle perimeter.</p> <p>+2 points (Average use of the circle) • Horse is only slightly inconsistent in using the 25' radius of the circle.</p> <p>+1 point (Adequate use of the circle) • Horse is shown in a circle radius of less than 25'.</p> <p>0 points (General use of the circle) • Potentially dangerous slack in the line. • Horse pulls exhibitor out of circle.</p>														
<p>PENALTIES -5 points per infraction • Failure to demonstrate the correct lead, jog/trot for an adequate distance to allow for proper evaluation.</p>														
<p>DISQUALIFICATION • Evidence of lameness. • Horse falls. (A horse is considered to have fallen when it is on its side and all four legs are extended in the same direction.) • Improper equipment, evidence of abuse, exhibitor disrespect to judge, or other violation of ApHCC rules. • Blatant striking of horse to cause forward or lateral movement with longe whip. • Horse steps over or becomes entangled in the longe line. • Failure to show at all three gaits in both directions. • Horse becomes loose in the arena.</p>
