

2007 ApHCC Trail Score Sheet

½ point penalty

Each tick of log, pole, cone, obstacle

1 point penalty

Each hit or stepping on log, pole, cone, obstacle
 Incorrect gait (including break of gait) at walk or jog for two strides or less

Both front or hind feet in single-strided slot or space

Skipping over or failing to step into required space

Split pole in lope-over

Failure to meet correct strides on trot-over and lope-over obstacles

3 point penalties

Break of gait at walk or jog for more than two strides

Out of lead or break of gait at lope (except when correcting an incorrect lead)

Knocking down elevated pole, cone, barrel, plant obstacle or severely disturbing obstacle

Stepping outside confines of, falling, or jumping off or out of obstacle with one foot

5 point penalties

Dropping slicker or object required to be carried on course

Use of either hand to instill fear

Blatant disobedience

First refusal, balk or attempt to evade obstacle by shying or backing more than two strides

Stepping outside confines of, falling or jumping off or out of obstacle with more than 1 foot

Loss of control or letting go of gate or dropping rope gate

Second refusal, balk, or attempt to evade obstacle by shying or backing more than 2 strides

Failure to demonstrate correct lead or gait, if designated

Failure to complete obstacle

Failure to follow correct line of travel within or between obstacles

Penalty Score 0

Use of more than one finger between reins

Use of romals other than in Rule #274

Performing obstacles incorrectly or other than in specified order

No attempt to perform an obstacle

Equipment failure that delays completion of pattern

Fall of horse and/or rider on course

Use of prohibited appointments

Excessively or repeatedly touching horse on neck to lower head

Failure to enter, exit or work obstacle from correct side or direction, including overturns of more than ¼ turn

Failure to work obstacle in any manner than how it's described by the course

Riding outside designated boundary of the arena or course area

Two hand on the reins (except on a Junior horse shown in two hands)

Changing hands on reins, when riding in one hand, except to negotiate obstacle

Third refusal, anywhere on course

An exhibitor will be penalized a maximum of 15 points on any one obstacle.

Horses with clean or minor fault trips over course will be considered before horses who have been assessed the maximum 15 penalty points on any obstacle in the final scoring and placing.
